



Parent's & Supporter's Code of Conduct

By registering your child to play football with Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club, parents, carers, family, friends and supporters agree to be bound by the Rules, Regulations and Policies of the Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club, the Moorabbin Saints Junior Football League & AFL Victoria

In respect to the Code of Conduct it is expected that all parents & supporters will adhere to the following:

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do – & many such comments are actually now illegal.

Failure to adhere to the Rules, Regulations and Policies of either of the Club, the League or AFL Victoria may result in disciplinary action, which may include the player being de-registered.
