



Playing in A higher Age Group

In general terms the club insists that each player plays within his or her age group (as determined by their age at January 1st). However, it is recognised that sometimes a player may be asked to play in a higher age group to make up the numbers. By this we mean that players should only be asked to play in a higher age group to have, at most, two players on the bench so that players ordinarily in that team get a fair go. Players asked to play up a grade are not to receive game time at the expense of kids who would normally play in that team.

In the event of a child playing in a higher age group, a parent or guardian of the child must sign a consent form which is available from the Team Manager.

In any event a player may only play in an age group one year higher than his or her normal age based eligibility.
