## CLUB HISTORY

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organised activity for the 1st Hampton Scout group in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self-confidence, self-control and the desire of a player to improve his ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers today.

Initially in 1920, games were played socially against other Scout Groups. The club as we know it today was established in 1929 and as the incentive to play in a higher standard became apparent, another football competition was sought.

In 1931, Hampton Rovers was admitted to the Metropolitan Amateur Football League and played Richmond United at Burnley in its first game. The competition was renamed the Victorian Amateur Football Association (VAFA) in 1933 (a competition in which the club still participates today) and changed the colours to the current Green & Gold.

The club won the 'A Section' Premiership in 1951 and in doing so, became the first club to win flags in all four senior sections of the VAFA. In total, the club has claimed nine senior premierships including back-to-back wins in 1946-47 and 2013-14. Nine Reserve and ten Under 19 premierships have also been won by the Rovers in the VAFA.

1963 saw the club move from Ludstone Street to our present home on the corner of David Street and Bluff Road. In 2002 this ground was formally named "Boss James Reserve" in memory of the club's founder.

In 1979 the club started its youth policy by introducing Junior Grades. The aims were to provide an extensive link with the local community and a development scheme and feeder base for the senior sides. The club now fields 28 junior teams in the South Metro Junior Football League, with over 600 boys and girls.

The club hosted the first VAFA Women's match in 2017, under lights at Boss James Reserve, and in 2019, fielded a total of seven female teams, including five junior girls, U18's and senior women's.

Hampton Rovers has maintained an honest and hard-working approach to its administration and has a deeply etched tradition, not only with the VAFA and SMJFL, but with the community at large. The club also maintains a high profile with the local media.

The club celebrated its 90th year in 2019, is in a healthy position and well placed for a successful next decade as it builds towards its centenary.

## TREASURER'S REPORT

This year has seen unprecedented challenges for sporting clubs both financially and delivering their purpose in the community. We navigated the Covid-19 crisis not knowing from one week to the next whether our season was going to go ahead.

Our players registered to play, and we pushed on hoping the season would get off the ground. The Board had to make some early decisions, mostly imposed by Victoria's restrictions, not to operate our canteen, bar and home game lunches, all major income streams for the Club. Then the blows kept coming – first the VAFA cancelled the Seniors season, then the SMJFL and AFL cancelled Juniors and Auskick seasons four days out from the first round.

At this point we went into survival mode to ensure the Club would come out of 2020 financially intact. I was fortunate to have the Seniors Treasurer, Megan McCartney, working with me throughout this season. Although it wasn't a normal season for Treasurers, it had its challenges and it was great to have Megan's support making key financial decisions as well as having a laugh and venting our frustration of being in lockdown.

The Board's aim was to end the season in a breakeven position, and we made decisions to deliver that including refunding 80% of all Junior registrations (approximately \$110k), retaining 20% to cover already incurred costs related to pre-season and mobilising the season proper. The Seniors made similar decisions and started running weekly online raffles to raise required funds.

We also had great support from our Seniors members donating their club memberships (approx. \$7k), our sponsors continuing to support us (approx. \$24k), continued support from the Roverians (\$2k) and donations from Junior parents (approx. \$2k). The Juniors also ran a successful merchandise/uniform sale prior to the cancellation of the season thanks to Marcus Nolan, Jeanette Boyd-Turner and Sarah-Jane Clarkson.

After expenses of \$95,283, the club reported a small profit of \$2,393. This leaves the Club in a very sound financial position ready to start the 2021 season, including our term deposit thanks to the generous donation by Peter Street's estate back in 2015. Note that as the Club's income was under \$250K, we are not required to undertake an independent audit of the Financial Statements in 2020.

This will be my last year as Juniors Treasurer and will be handing over the reins at the AGM. I would like to thank the Junior and Senior Committees and the Board for their support in implementing initiatives at the Club that set us up for ongoing financial success to ensure we can continue to invest in delivering our purpose of fostering and furthering football and providing social connections in our community. I would also like to thank the many volunteers who donate their time as without them we would not have a Club.

## SENIOR FOOTBALL REPORT

What might have been...

After successfully staying up in Premier C, and with the direction been given to raise the bar again, the Senior group embarked on a strong pre-season. With the addition of a specialist strength and conditioning coach in Nathan Bonney, who came to us with a long history in sport science, umpiring, TAC Cup football and as a teacher, the players undertook a hard, but structurally sound pre-season program. From biomechanical training and education, to numerous small sided games, it was clear for the players whom completed most if not all sessions, they were extremely prepared for the 2020 season.

From a coaching panel perspective, it was pleasing to see and hear that the training although tough at times, was met with enthusiasm and encouraging banter. Starting back in mid-November and then again in late January, the numbers at training were very good. All was going well leading into our pre-season camp in Torquay which was attended by close to 40 players over the weekend. A mixture of hard training, skill drills and match simulation, the players were also able to spend some time bonding.

Unfortunately, upon our return leading into the practice matches, COVID kicked in which brought everything to a halt. Disappointment was high as we genuinely felt this was the best prepared group in a long time. Fast forward to June when we were able to resume with some glimmer of hope to play in July, and with restrictions which were a logistical nightmare for all involved – a huge thanks to Jamie and Miranda for helping run this off-field, plus the senior committee for their support. We had consistently 40-45 players across the two 45 minute sessions in June – the highest being 53 players, and with no official start date, this was a huge commitment and a display of positive attitude by all.

Unfortunately, we were called off in early July.

However, the positives were that in 2020, we had a number of players return to the club, to name just a few, Josh `Speedy` McPherson and Nathan Smith. We were lucky to have some players return from long term injuries – Christian Carnovale and Benji Audgie who were moving beautifully.

We look forward to 2021 and the hard work behind the scenes has already begun, for what will seem like an eternity until we play our first game again.

For the Under 19s, coming off the back of a Premiership, numbers again looked strong. With some filtering up to the senior bracket, it was pleasing to see many new under 19s attend training.

In the Women's team, Corey had huge numbers to work with and again, and were all set for a successful year after playing off in the Grand Final.

## JUNIOR PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I was privileged to be nominated and voted in as the Juniors President for 2020, taking over from the previous President, Jason Nicholl. As a member of the Rovers Committee and Board for a few years, I didn't underestimate the work that needed to be done to continue building a strong, community-focused football club. By the end of January, our registrations were showing us that we were set for another great year of children keen to play with the Hampton Rovers. We were on target of another 500+ kids signing up to play.

Unfortunately, as news spread quickly of the global COVID-19 pandemic, we needed to reconsider our plans and put the health and safety of our players, our volunteers and our broader community front and centre. On 14 March 2020, we cancelled all training and pre-season activities, and started working actively on our contingency plans.

Despite the setback, the SMJFL and Rovers community focused on staying active, enthusiastic and optimistic. We weren't losing hope. But we needed to ensure that we did everything possible to reduce the risk to our players, as well as ensuring that we were abiding by the Government's restrictions. Alisdair Smyth, Operations Manager, took on the role of COVID Safety Officer. By the middle of June, he had completed Return to Training and Play protocol briefings with all Team Managers, coaches, volunteers and parents (around 500 people) to ensure we were ready to go when the green light was given to start our already delayed season. However, it was not to be. Despite getting in a few training sessions and our players ready to have their first game, the Victorian Government's harder lockdown meant that our season was done.

We then focused on keeping our players engaged. Fit, healthy and to keep those essential footy skills up. There were training videos, competitions and tips to keep the #RoversPassion alive. Whenever I was out around Hampton, and I saw a Hampton Rovers hoodie, I knew that we remained a strong footy community. Now, as we head towards 2020's close, there is hope that there is a 4-week alternative competition from the middle of November with the SMJFL. Interest levels have been high in such a mini competition; a testament to the energy and enthusiasm of all of our players.

There is no doubt that COVID-19 has had a significant impact on the local community. However, what it has highlighted to me is the importance of community sport to enable connection and health. They say you don't fully appreciate what you have until you lose it. That was certainly the case with junior football and sport in general this year.

As we look to 2021, the Hampton Rovers Juniors Committee has commenced planning for what will be a much needed 2021 season. We are optimistic that we are over the worst and the 2021 season will be stronger than ever.

I would like to extend my genuine thanks all of our sponsors who have continued to support the Club, even though they too were going through rough times. Please remember to support your local businesses and our sponsors.

My thanks also go to our committee members for their support and tireless efforts to try get a season up and running and keep our playing community connected.

A special thanks to Gavin Sharp, Secretary, who retires from the Junior Committee this year as his sons' head into our Senior football program. Gavin has made a massive contribution to our club over many years and his expertise will be sadly missed.

Thanks also to Kate Robb, Treasurer, Alisdair Smyth, Operations Manager (and one of four finalists as 2020 SMJFL administrator), Paul Carrigan, Head of Football and Lara Tascone, Social Coordinator. And a final thanks to our parents and players – this won't be a year that we forget!
